Compare the stories of these two men and their mothers with the stories of Mary, the mother of Jesus and Naomi, the mother-in-law of Ruth.

CONNECTING

How would you imagine the mothers or fathers of these disabled men viewed their lives? If you were in their shoes, how would you view your life?

How do you identify with the parents in these stories?

EQUIPPING

What does this example say to our priorities or mission today?

How will you respond to the opportunity of challenges in your life?

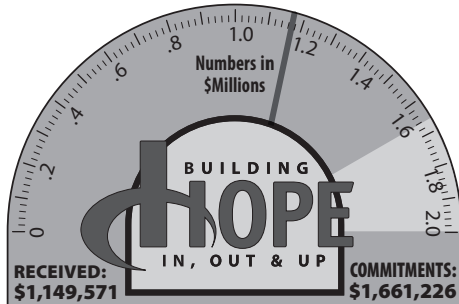
