



CONNECTING OPENER: How tall are you? How did you get that tall?

Read Acts 3:12-4:22

DISCOVERING

Where were John and Peter when this scene unfolds? Who are present?

What had the apostles been teaching the people in 3:12-26?

What was the reaction of the people, the priests, the captain of the temple guard and the Sadducees? Why? What happens to John and Peter as a result? (vv. 4:1-4)

Who were the rulers, elders, teachers of the law, Annas, Caiaphas, John, Alexander and the other men of the high priest's family mentioned in verses 4:5-12? Why did these people ask the question in verse 7?

How did Peter respond? What is significant about "filled with the Holy Spirit"?

How does the council view Peter and John? What does the word "ordinary" mean?

How does the council try to manipulate the situation to their benefit? What was the outcome?

CONNECTING

How would you respond to a situation like Peter and John's?

Explain the ways that we see ourselves as "ordinary"?

EQUIPPING

What principles for Christian behavior before authorities do you see Peter and John exemplify?

What will you think and do when you are next confronted with an "opportunity"?

How can the group help you rely on being "filled with the Holy Spirit"?

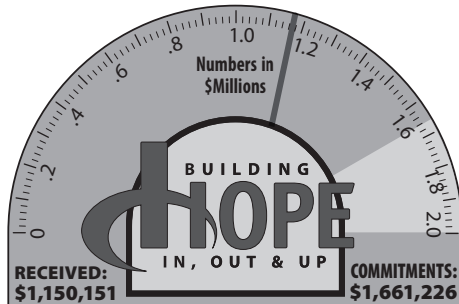
