- Who accepted the gospel in 8:26-40? What status did this person have with the Jews?
- How was this person's conversion significant to the progress of the gospel?
- What convinced this person to be baptized?

CONNECTING

- How do you feel when you are around people that are marginalized by society?
- Do you think that people follow God for the wrong motives? Explain.

EQUIPPING

- How is this scripture relevant to your life? What sins to avoid, examples to follow, or truths about God does it offer?
- What one insight from this scripture would you like to apply? How can you do this?
- Do you know the Bible well enough to address the eunuch's questions? How can you grow in faith so you will be prepared for similar opportunities?

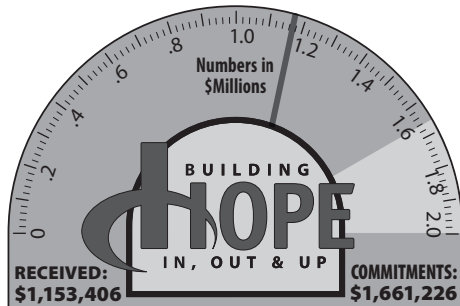
