Who is Ananias? What is significant about the role of Ananias in Saul's conversion?

What is the response of both believers and non-believers to Saul and his ministry in Damascus or Jerusalem?

What was the result of Saul's time in Jerusalem? Why did he need to leave? What is significant about his leaving? Where did he go?

CONNECTING

Have you ever suddenly realized that your whole way of dealing with God was wrong? If so, how did you feel? What did you do?

How would you have felt in Ananias' place? How would you have felt in Barnabas' place?

In what ways do you relate to the experiences of Saul?

EQUIPPING

Has committing yourself to Christ changed your outlook and way of life as radically as Saul's life was changed? Why or why not?

What would your life be like if you took Saul's attitude? What and how do you want to change?

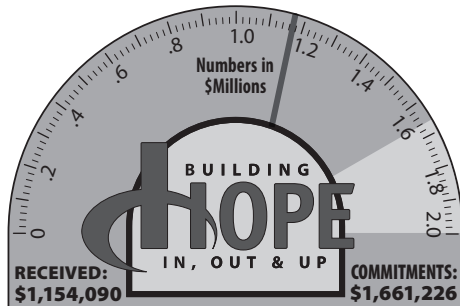
