What does God lead Peter to say? What happens while Peter is speaking?

How is this different from the previous appearances of the Holy Spirit we have seen in Acts?

**CONNECTING**

How would you respond if God put you in a trace to communicate a new truth that contradicted something you had previously considered a truth?

What does it take for you to let go of a belief that has been supported your entire life?

**EQUIPPING**

What does this scripture provide as insight into your life?

How will you be open and available to God when he has a new truth or belief he is revealing?

What do you think that requires from you to be successful?

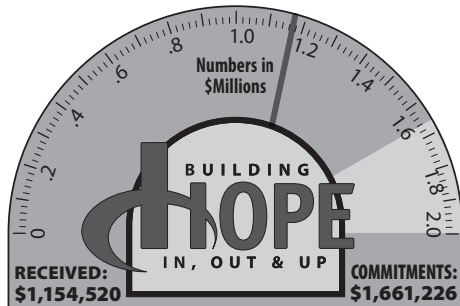
