In what way were the Jews responsible for their blindness and deafness to the gospel (vs. 26-27)?

Why do you think Luke wrote so little about the church in Rome?

What do you know about the life of Paul after Acts?

How would you feel if you were in Paul's shoes at this point of his life?

What event in the Book of Acts would you most like to have attended yourself? Why?

What are the examples that Paul sets for all Christians?

How did Luke's choice of information in 28:17-31 serve his overall plan for Acts?
